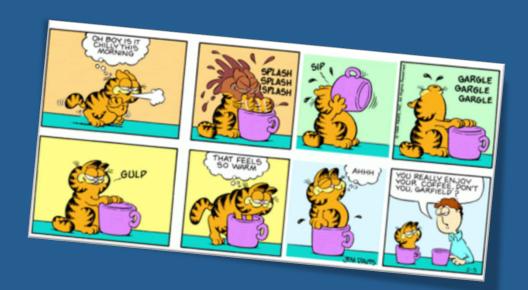


# Content of Training Modules

#### How to Participate in the Training Modules

- The modules are offered online so you can participate from home when you have free time
- You will need a computer (or tablet/phone) with access to the Internet
- If possible, work together with other colleagues at your school/region so you can exchange ideas and support each other

# Structure of Training Modules

#### Each module follows a three-step structure:

- 1. Print the presentation slides for easy note-taking
- 2. Watch the video presentation (webinar), reflecting on how you can implement the ideas in your ASP classroom
- 3. Try out one or two ideas with your students, and participate in the discussion forum. Describe what you did and share photos/videos of your classroom

## Video Presentations

- The webinars come from the "American English" program.
- Originally presented live with teachers participating from around the world.
- Used chat boxes and polls to encourage participation, but you will not have the opportunity to use these features with the recorded webinar.
- The teachers in the live webinar had to submit their attendance so they could later receive a certificate. This does not apply to you.

## Video Presentations

- Print the Power Point slides so you can take notes as you watch the video presentation.
- The speaker will stop the presentation at certain points to ask questions and opinions. If you are watching the video with other colleagues, discuss your answers with them.
- If you are watching the video alone, write down your answers and reflect on how the ideas presented relate to your classroom.

#### Discussion Forum

- After you watch the video presentation, make plans to implement at least one idea/activity in your own classroom.
- Take photos/videos of your students doing the activity and reflect: What worked well? How can I improve this activity next time?
- Participate in our Discussion Forum. Briefly describe how you implemented the activity, share a video or photos of your students, and discuss successes/ challenges.
- Ask questions, exchange ideas, and share experiences with other ASP teachers from all the regions of Panama!
